Class Fir - Autumn 1st half term 2015

This half-term the children will be studying the following areas:-

Literacy: recounts and letters; grammar, spelling and punctuation; reading, phonics, handwriting and speaking and listening. Our class novel is The Iron Man by Ted Hughes and much of our literacy work will be drawn from this.

Mathematics: number and place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions and decimals, mental maths and statistics.

Science: rocks and volcanoes.

History: a study of a non-European area (Baghdad). This will link into our topic 'From here to there' which looks at journeys.

Geography: map work, grid references, co-ordinates, routes, rivers, mountains and climate.

R.E.: war and peace, early bible stories, creation, the beginnings of Islam.

Art: clay sculpture, sketching, mixed media.

I.T.: e-safety, support programs for curriculum areas.

D.T.: structures.

Music: painting with sound. Exploring sound colours.

MFL: French, spoken simple greetings, numbers, everyday objects, food.

P.E.: Cross country, tennis and gymnastics.

PSHCE: New beginnings, British values.

Our P.E. lessons take place on a Monday and Wednesday and the children will need their full kit on these days. Thank you for supporting your child with reading and maths targets at home.
