Sports Funding 2016-17

The school funding £8287 at Linby cum Papplewick Primary School has been used to:

- Access the Ashfield District School Sports Network (£750) – this provides a rich and varied inter school competitive sports calendar and staff training in the delivery of quality PE and the development of Sports Ambassadors in school (pupils)
- Provide high quality coaching by specialist sport coaches for PE in school (£6577) (including hockey, basketball, tennis, athletics, cricket, orienteering, tag rugby, multi-skills, golf, pop lacrosse)
- Participation in intra & inter-school competitive sports (£1500)

Impact

Children love sport at our school, participate in lots of extra-curricular sport and standards are very high

- The school was awarded a 'Gold Medal' accreditation for school sport in 2016-17 academic year following the 'Gold Medal' in 2015-16 & 2014-15 and the 'Silver Medal' in 2013-14
- The school qualified for the Ashfield Games for the fourth year running having been Ashfield School Games Champions in 2014
- The school participated in 30 Ashfield District events (4 infant) and was awarded 26 medals (9 Gold, 13 Silver and 4 Bronze).
- Amongst our achievements are retaining the County Football Small School Championship for the third consecutive year (and competing strongly in the 12 county Midlands finals), Ashfield Cricket Champions (Year 6 & Year 5) & County Finalists, District Runners up in Basketball & Hockey
- The school has an extensive range of after school sports clubs (including football, tennis, basketball, hockey, dance, cricket, gymnastics, rugby, table tennis) and active links to many local sports clubs

We feel the children's achievements are particularly significant due to the size of our school (120 pupils).
